



## Immunization & Health Records

### Immunizations:

Parents must provide a DH680 (Immunization Certificate) on their child’s first date of enrollment or they must provide evidence of Religious or Medical Exemption. Some children in care may not have current immunizations.

### Expiration of Immunization & Health Records:

According to Pinellas County License Board, there is not a grace period if immunization or health records expire. The license board rule is that the child whose record has expired must not attend until they are in compliance or the preschool can be found in noncompliance and subjected to disciplinary actions from the license board including fines, probation and losing their license to operate. ***We will make every effort to give parents advance notice of when the records will expire but it is imperative that parents know the expiration dates and have doctor appointments set up in advance.*** Always ask for the health and immunization record when your child goes to the doctor. Thank you for making it a priority to keep our records in compliance. It is not our wish to dismiss a child for noncompliance of health records but we will have no choice and no flexibility in the matter.
